The Editor reserves the right to reject the article if it exceeds 4 printed pages. All submitted articles will be edited to conform to the style of *JGSI* and if major changes are necessary, the author will be contacted. Page proofs will be sent to the authors in pdf form. After publication, the author will be provided a pdf copy of the printed article. These articles will be reviewed and published on a fast track basis.
